Crestknit are supplying coach free of charge and will return to Jolimont Road at approx. 1 pm

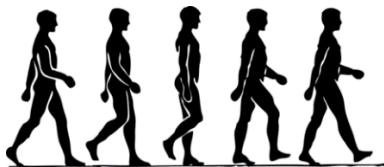
