**CURRENT AFFAIRS DISCUSSION GOUP – Bill Wallis 9874-3636**

Opening topic at our July meeting was the recent statement by AGL that it was deferring its development of an import gas terminal at Crib Point until late 2022 .Possible delays in obtaining environmental approvals could hold up the program. The recent ruling by the IOC was that the Summer Olympic MUST be held in July or August. This effectively rules out all countries where winter falls in this time frame-interestingly this equates to a significant "slack" in major sporting events in the USA - coincidentally large American TV sports network provides the majority of funding for the IOC Other topics covered included a media report that Federal Government agencies have around 101 investigations of Financial entities currently in hand following on from the Royal Commission. The Government is also handling asylum requests of 81,000 persons who arrived by plane and overstayed their tourist visas, usually over 90% are refused.
