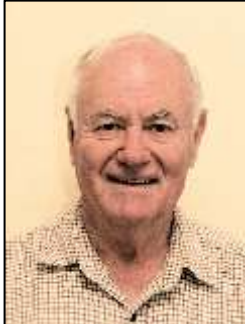

**NUNAWADING – SIMPSON PARK TO HEATHERDALE RESERVE WALK**

Distance 3 & 6 km

Grade: Easy

Duration 2 hours

Start: 10.00 am from car park at sport oval – club house & toilets

Starting and Finishing point: as above from Simpson Park

Facilities: Shelter, Toilet, benches, drink fountains

Bring: Lunch, chairs

Shared good path: Walkers, few bikes.

Starting at the car park we are going S/E into Summers Trail, Heatherdale Ponding and Davison St. and for the 3er back to Simpson Park with a loop around the oval (as per map). The 6 er follow the additional path through the Heatherdale Reserve (as per map) and back track to the car park.

**Approach:** Use instructions with Melways. Note TL = Turn left, TR Turn Right, SA= Straight ahead  
Take Whitehorse Rd. going East, crossing Mitcham Rd. TR into Cochrane Rd. TR on bit. Road to car park. On Canterbury Rd. going East crossing Mitcham Rd, TL into Glenburnie Rd to the end, TR and TL and into car park.
