May - Colin Neave

Colin will give us a most interesting talk as he recounts facets of his very extensive career in law, consumer affairs, and government administration. He served as Chairman of the Commonwealth Consumer Affairs Advisory Council from 1997 to 2013 and was President of the Administrative Review Council. He was honoured with a Lifetime Achievement Award from the Society of Consumer Affairs Professionals for his contributions as an ombudsman and his work in resolving issues. In June 2005, Colin was recognised for his service to public administration and the banking and finance industry, and was appointed as a Member of the Order of Australia.

During his talk, Colin shares his journey from working at Myers part-time in 1958 to serving as the Chief Ombudsman of the Financial Ombudsman Service, Chairperson of the Legal Services Board of Victoria, the Australian Banking Industry Ombudsman, and Vice Chair of the Australian Press Council.

He has held many other high-level positions in public sectors in several areas, including Deputy Secretary of the Commonwealth Attorney-General's Department, Managing Director of the Legal Aid Commission of NSW, Secretary of the Victorian Attorney- General's Department, and Director-General of the South Australian Department of Public and Consumer Affairs.
