The Murdoch Story

In 1928, journalist & newspaper executive Keith Murdoch gave his 19-year-old bride, Elizabeth Greene, a small farm as a wedding present. Keith revitalised the modest weatherboard cottage into a weekend retreat.

Elizabeth was distressed by the ostentatious renovation of the home and, in the coming decades, set about “burying the house within the garden”. While this commenced in 1930, in 1944, a devastating fire tore through Cruden farm, destroying hundreds of plants and trees, but the house survived.

Beyond the formal gardens lies the ‘outer garden’ and the stunning lake Dame Elisabeth created in 1987.

Behind the lake are oaks planted by her children in the 1980s.

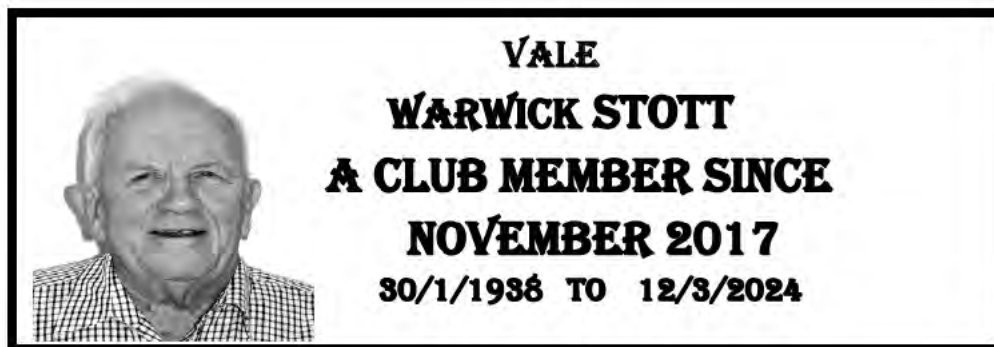

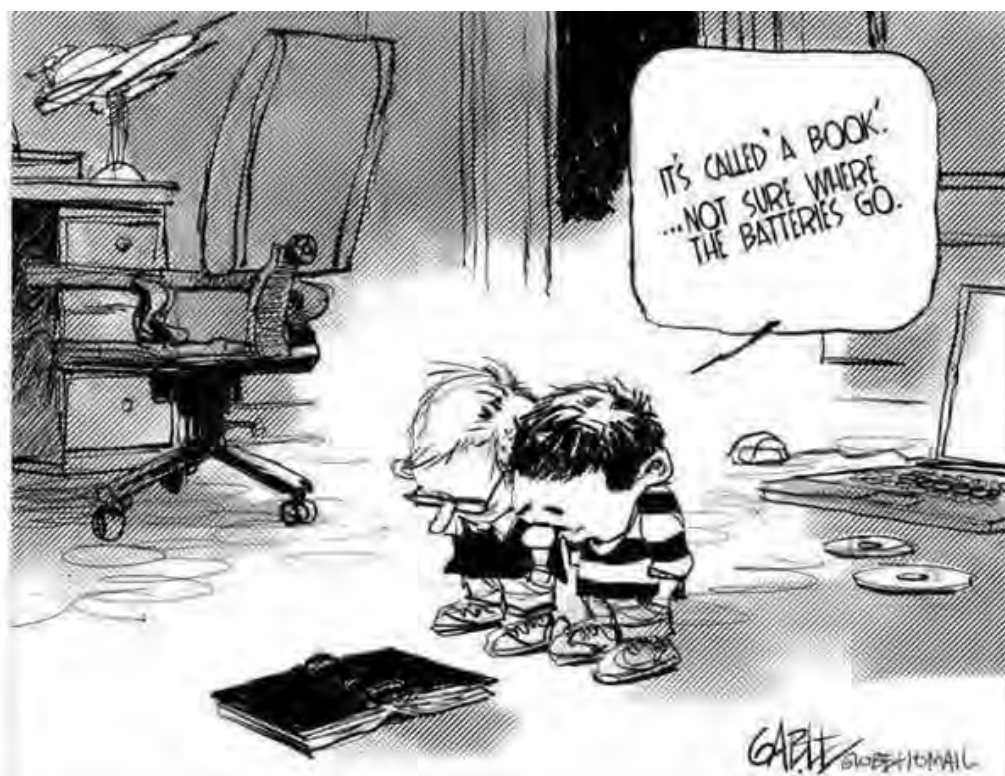


